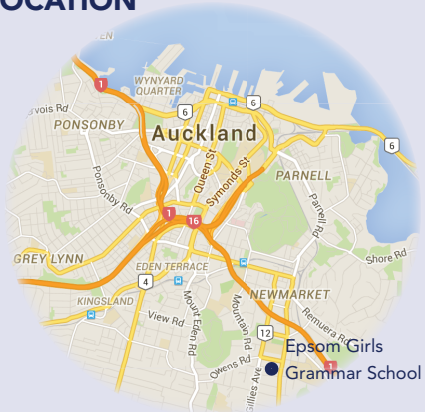
Students value and enjoy the immense opportunities that EGGS provides including a competitive sporting environment, expert coaching, and leadership programmes for personal development.
