A Gift from the residue of your Estate

The "residue" of your Estate is the pool of assets remaining once your estate's expenses have been paid and all specific legacies have been paid or satisfied.

If you wish to leave the whole or a part of your residuary Estate to The Epsom Girls Grammar School Foundation you will need to include the appropriate wording in the residuary provisions of your Will. You will need to discuss this with your legal advisor so that the appropriate provision can be made.




