NCEA examinations have started today and continue through to early December. For senior students this means making the most of study leave time to prepare well for each exam.

Key reminders:

- Focused study will advantage you
- Know the date and time of each exam
- Arrive in plenty of time and in correct uniform
- Make sure you understand exactly what is being asked in any exam question and answer the question asked. It seems obvious but is very important.

Some Year 9 and 10 classes have been re-roomed. Some key messages:

- No one is to go over/through/around a barrier or door with a no entry sign on it from 9:30am to 12:30pm and 2:00pm to 5:00pm
- Get from one side of the school to the other via the back of D/E block or along Silver Rd... not through the Library/Science Quad
- Get to the classes in the Verna Dowdle block (SP4, D1, D2, DS0, DS1, D11, D12, D13, D21, D22) using the doors/stairs at the Science end of the block, not the Breezeway stairwell/Science quad
- Get to the Library/L11 from the front of the school NOT past D9; when you leave the Library/L11 TURN RIGHT NOT LEFT
- Tuck shop is open at Interval and lunch but do not go into Science Quad at Interval

The New Zealand team does extremely well at these World events, and this year they were placed 3rd behind Argentina and Russia. Caitlin competed well in Sparring and Patterns, gaining valuable experience. She returned from Germany to win Gold in Sparring at the Oceania/New Zealand Championships in July, and was then awarded 2019's Best Female Black Belt for results across all 3 National Under 18 Tournaments. Caitlin currently trains at the Van Roon Martial Arts Club in Mt Eden.
